Secretary's report

- Minutes of the July 18, 2019 executive board meeting were reviewed and approved. Moved by Misslin, seconded by Marshall. All approved by voice vote.
- Letters were sent to 30 plus residents regarding lot and Southwest Water dues.
- A response letter was send out regarding a complaint form.

Treasurer's report

- Checking account balance is approximately \$168,000.00, excluding the \$40,000 set aside for the water project.
- Lot fees collected to date totaled \$28,500.00
- Water fees collected to date totaled \$10,296.00
- Treasurer's report approved. Motion by Becker, seconded by Misslin. All approved by voice vote.

Old Business

Bylaws and Covenants

 Mark Kaffar was present at the meeting and agreed to the possibility of reviewing the Bylaws and Covenants once the Board has completed their review.

Water Diversion Update

- Mark Kaffar presented several new updates to the project.
 - The original easement area was changed from 2.6 to 1.8 acres as it was determined that a smaller area was needed to complete the project.
 - .
 - Future developments in the area that may affect the project will require the approval of Lake Shore Estates, the Boeshans family and the Byrum family. These three entities will have the ability to negotiate items that may affect the use of the completed system.
 - Any future development that will affect the project must have a written water diversion plan for a 100 year event.
 - Lake Shore Estates, the Boeshans family and the Byrum family must consent, but won't
 unreasonably deny use of the completed system. These changes should give the Mercer
 County Water Board supervisor and the three entities more control over developments that
 may affect the completed system. Negotiations continue with the Byrums on the number of
 trees to be removed and the costs associated with said removal.
 - Motion by Becker, seconded by Marshall to sign the new Water Diversion Project agreement as presented. All approved by voice vote.

Lake Shore Forrest Drive Quote

Previous repair of Forrest Drive has not taken care of the concerns of affected lot owners. The
current plan to remove 18-24 inches of a 500 foot by 20-foot section of the road and replace with
scoria, fly ash, gravel came in considerably over budget. The bids came in above the budgeted
amount of \$13,000. Motion by Becker, seconded by Marshall to open bids on scaling back the road

project to include graveling 4-5 soft spots, graveling the cul-de-sac, and grading and crowning the entire length of Forrest Drive with existing road material. All approved by voice vote.
